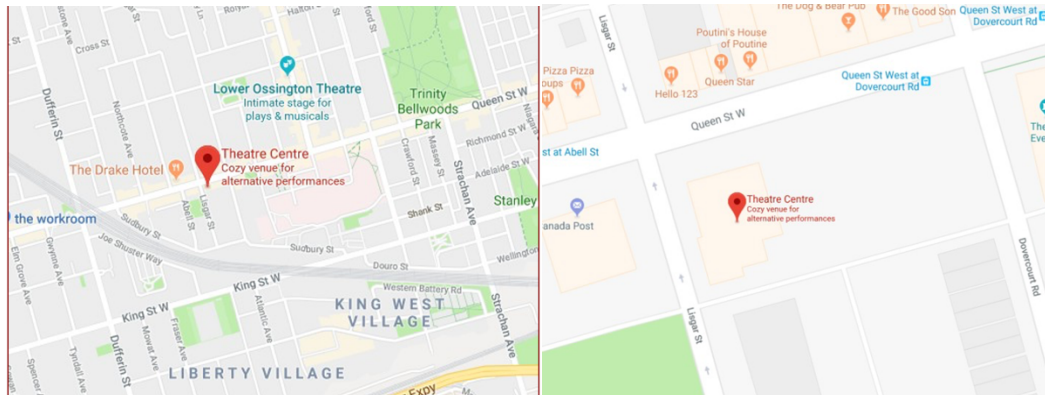

Where is the Theatre Centre?

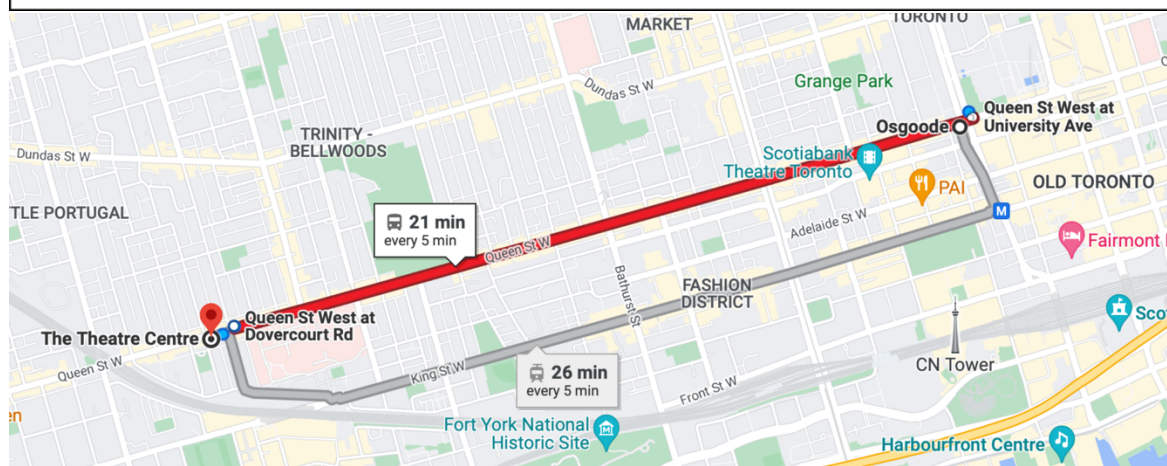


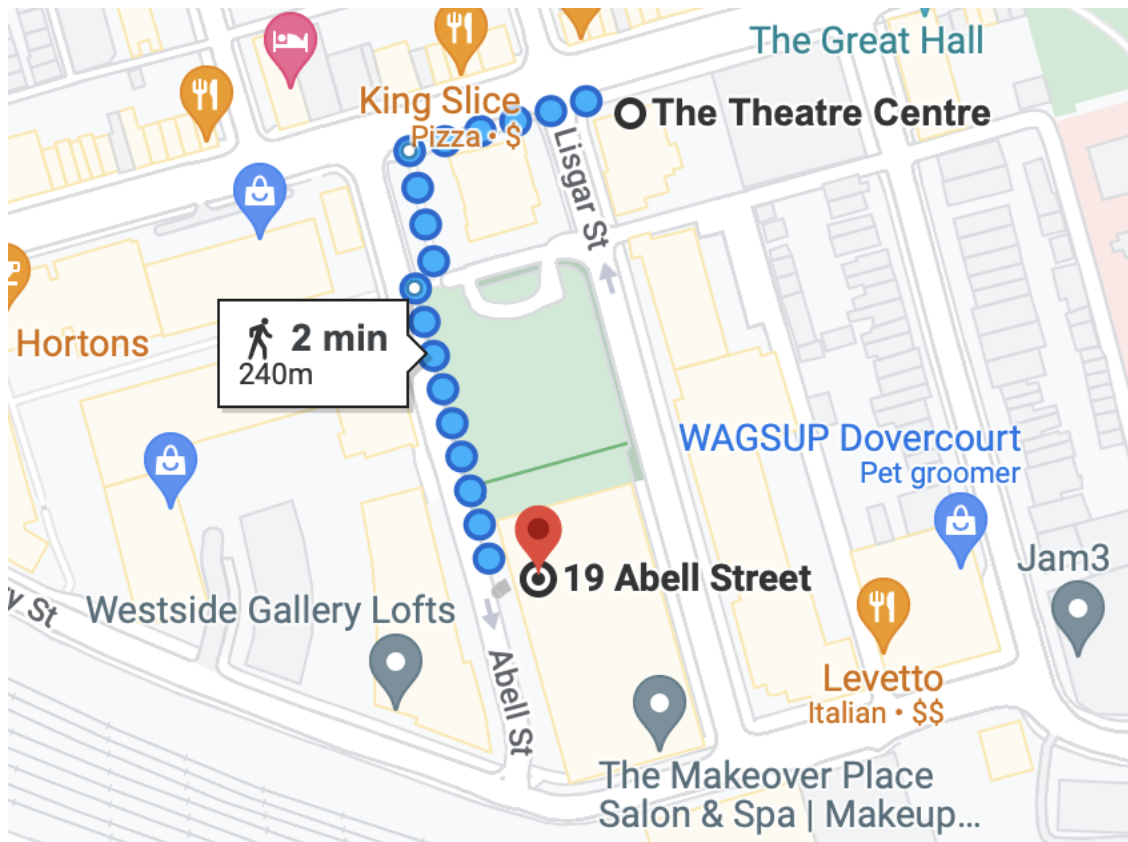
The Theatre Centre is located at the corner of Queen Street West (QSW) and Lisgar St.

Address: 1115 Queen Street West

Getting There

TTC: Osgoode Subway Station will take you closest to the Theatre Centre. Exit the subway station and arrive at the Queen Street West - University Avenue intersection. From here, take the 501 Streetcar along Queen Street West (QSW) to Dovercourt Rd. Walk West down QSW for about 2 min and arrive at The Theatre Centre on the left.





Parking: There is a Green P Car Park located about 3 minutes south of the Theatre Centre at **19 Abell St.** To access the parking lot from the Theatre Centre, head west down QSW towards Lisgar St and turn left onto Abell St. Drive south down Abell St. and arrive at the parking lot on your right.

The Building

This is what The Theatre Centre looks like:



This is the front of the building.



This is the building from the corner of Queen St. and Lisgar St.

Entering the Building



The Ramp: This ramp starts at Queen Street. It is beside the sidewalk on Lisgar Street.



The Main Doors: These are the main doors located at the front of the building.



The Stairs: These stairs are beside the sidewalk on Lisgar Street at the end of the ramp.



This button opens the outside door and is located on the left side of the entrance ramp. You can also pull the door to open it.



The outside door opens into the vestibule.



This button opens the inside door and is located on the right side of the vestibule. You can also pull the door to open it.

The Café



Here is what the Café looks like from the entrance with lots of people in it.



When you enter there are tables and benches and chairs.



There is a counter at the back where you can buy a drink or a snack when the café is open.



The whole space looks like this from the counter.

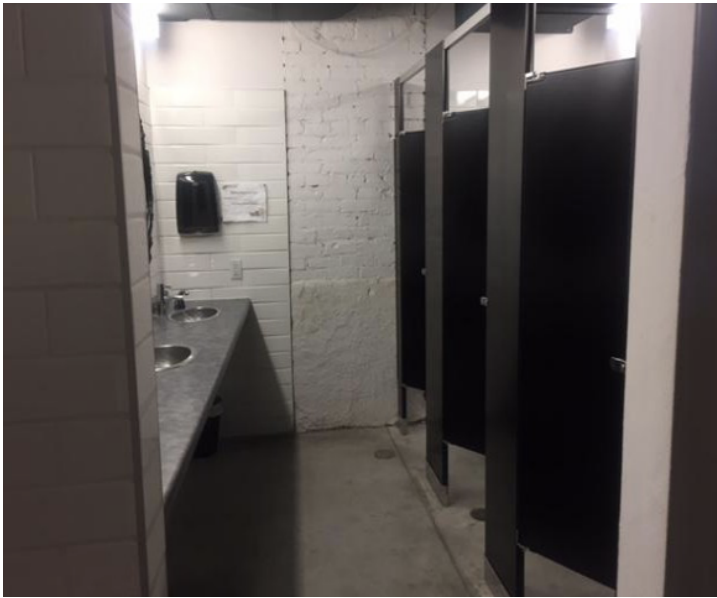
Washrooms (1st Floor)



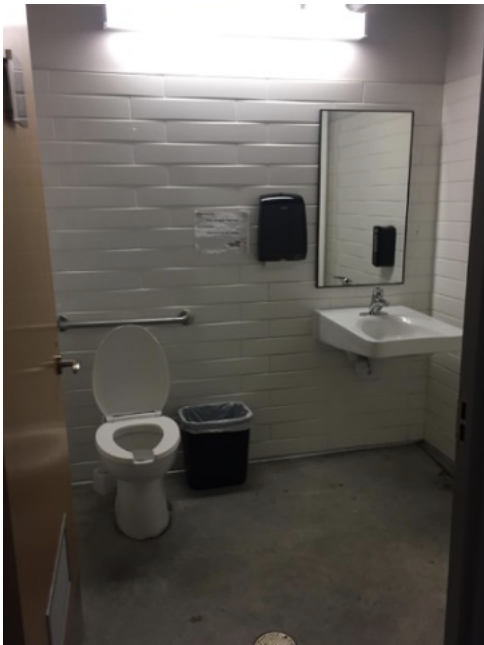
The washrooms are just around the corner from the café. To get there, turn left to exit the café and make another left (around this white wall) to get to the washrooms.



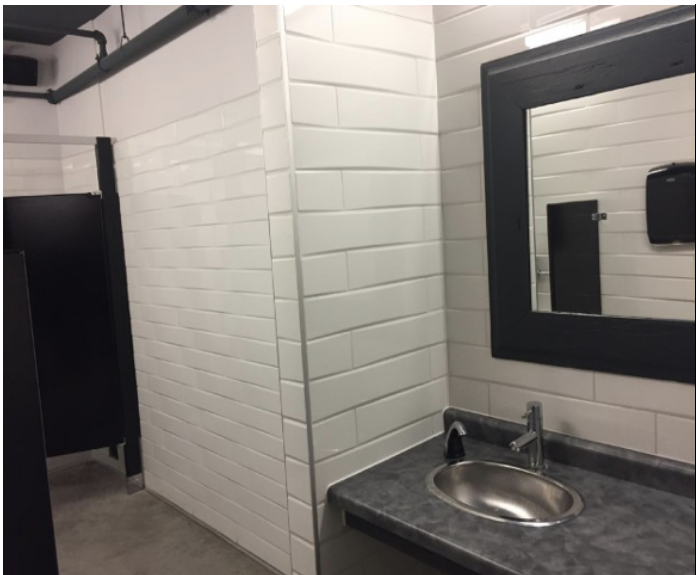
All three doors are close together. The women's washroom is on the left, the gender neutral and accessible washroom is in the middle, and the men's washroom is on the right.

This is the inside of the gender neutral and accessible washroom



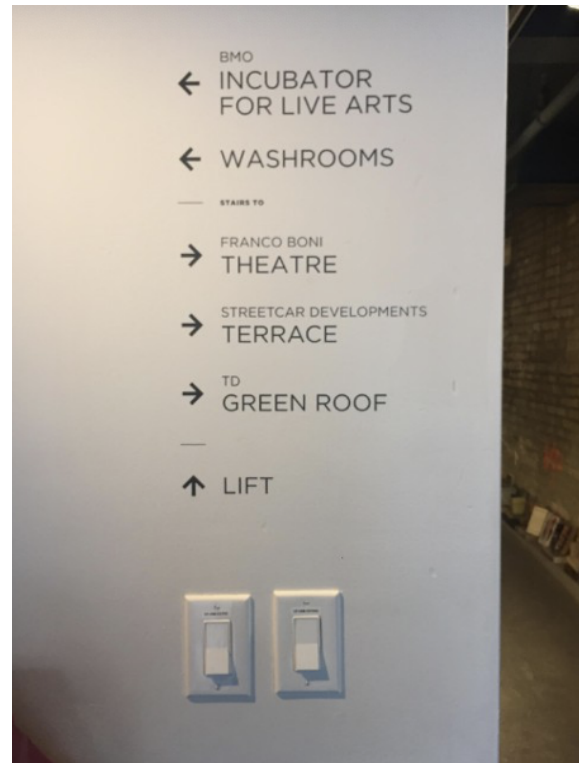
This is the inside of the men's washroom

The BMO Incubator

The incubator is a small theatre that is used for many different types of projects.



This door leads to the Incubator. It is to your immediate left outside of the café.



These directions will also help you.



This is what the BMO Incubator looks like on the inside with no chairs. Usually chairs are set along the concrete edges and the performance will take place inside the black square in the middle of the room. However, the seating configuration for each performance might look different.

The Second Floor



The stairway to the theatre is to your immediate right when you exit the café.



Go through this doorway. The stairs are on your left.



Go up these stairs to get to the theatre



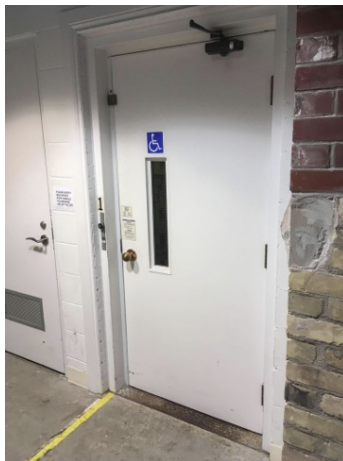
This door at the top of the stairs leads to our Gallery and the theatre.

The Lift



Start from the same place as the stairs and go to the end of this hallway



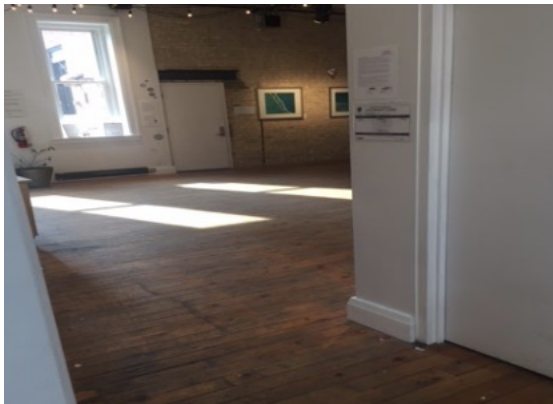
At the end of the hallway, the door is around the corner on the right.

This is what the gallery looks like with people in it.

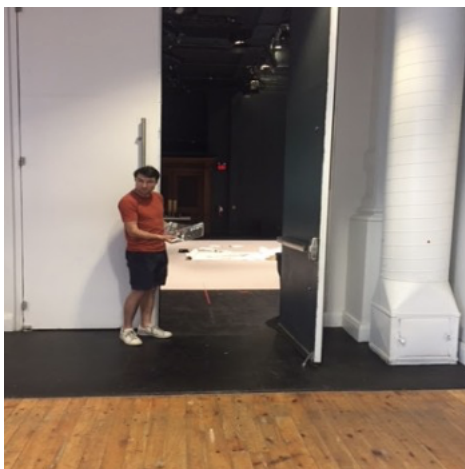
The Franco Boni Theatre

This is what it looks like when the theatre is open. A volunteer may stand at the door to take your ticket.

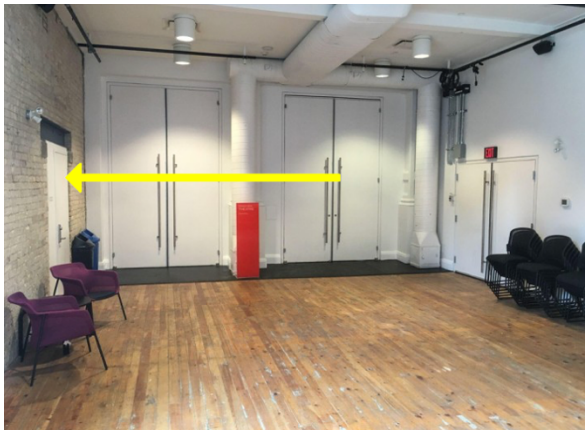
The TD Green Roof

After you go through the Gallery door, the washroom door is on your left

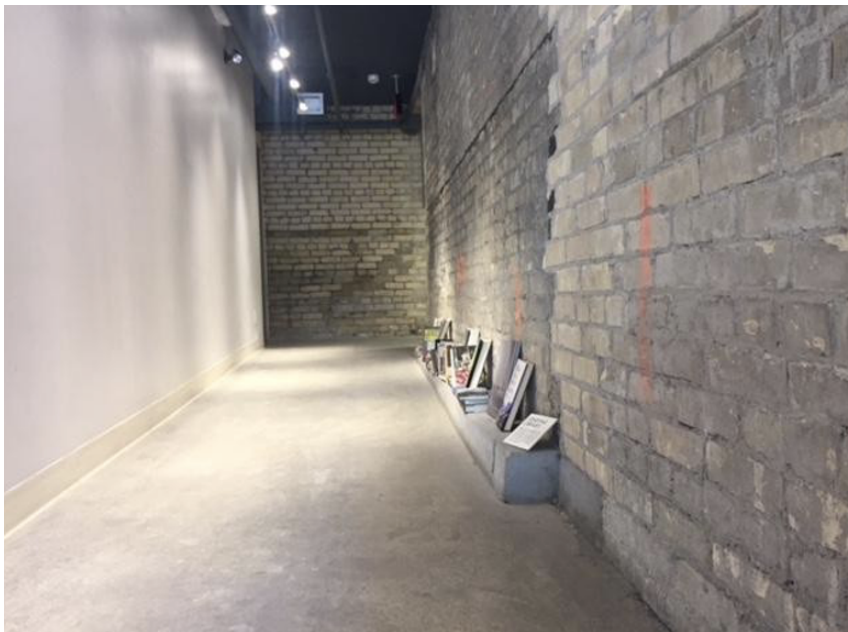


This is the inside of the washroom on the second floor.
